Michelangelo Lazzareschi (1992) approached music and the flute thanks to M<sup>o</sup> Antonio Barsanti in 2004. At the Istituto Musicale "L.Boccherini" in Lucca he was a student of M<sup>o</sup>R.Peruzzi in the Piano class until 2010; also in Lucca since 2010 he has been a student of M<sup>o</sup>F.Rogai in the Flute class with whom he graduated brilliantly in June 2014. In 2016 he graduated with top marks from the Conservatorio "G.Verdi" in Milan, where he was a student in the flute class of Maestro Diego Collino and was also followed by Maestro Marco Pace for chamber music, perfecting his skills under the guidance of many of the greatest flutists in activity, including Michele Marasco, Paolo Taballione, Andrea Oliva, Giampaolo Pretto and Mathias Ziegler. During this period, in addition to obtaining results in national and international competitions in duo with guitar or piano, he was also invited to represent the Conservatory of Milan and Italy in the important review "Jeunesses Musicales de Mediterranee" in Bastia (FR). He also had an important collaboration during MITO Festival, in which he participated in several editions, with Giampaolo Pretto in a trio for a particular Mozart project. His orchestral activity has led him to perform in many of the great theatres and halls in Italy and abroad, including the former Comunale di Firenze, Teatro Verdi in Pisa, Teatro del Maggio Musicale Fiorentino, Teatro Dal Verme, Teatro Comunale di Bologna, Sala Verdi (ConsMi), Triennale di Milano, LAC Lugano. Since 2019 he regularly performs in the season "Rondò" for Divertimento Ensemble-Milan.

He becomes active as Flute Teacher from A.S. 2017-18 at the SMIM of ICLucca3 and from 2019 at the Licei Musicali of Pisa and Lucca.
